### What is GOMA?


GOMA is a regional network of stakeholders, initiated by the Governors of the five Gulf States in 2004 to collectively address issues of common concern.


### Mission



# Governors' Action Plan IV


### **Overarching Goals**:

- Tracking restoration efforts


#### Commitments to:
